



Covid-19 Interim Behaviour Policy

School Rules

- Children to sanitise their hands on entry to the school building and every time that adults direct them to do so.
- Children are to wear school uniform in accordance with uniform policy.
- Class groups are to adhere to social distancing rules: at playtimes, lunchtime, during learning time and at the end of the school day. If a child ignores this rule and deliberately makes contact with another group, sanctions will apply.
- Children are to show all aspects of usual OLOL expectations when in school.

Rewards

- Team points
- Additional outside time for excellent class/group behaviour and attitude to learning

Sanctions

- First reminder of the rules
- Second reminder of the rules
- Removal from group to work with TA assigned to group
- Removal from group to work with member of leadership team
- Contact made with parents
- Fixed-term exclusion on the grounds of health and safety

If a child deliberately makes contact with other children outside of their group, they will immediately be removed from the group and a decision will be made by SLT as to the next course of action.

Either:

- 1.) Work with senior leader and re-integrated back into their designated classroom
- 2.) Parents contacted and the child is sent home
- 3.) Next school day – child is re-integrated back into their classroom following a strict reminder of the interim school rules.

All incidents to be recorded on CPOMS.
