Autumn

Creation

- recognise that we are made in the image and likeness of God
- have an understanding of the creation story
- hear the words of the Canticle of Creation

Miracles & the Sacrament of the Sick

- know a number of miracles that Jesus performed and identify how his actions brought change to people's lives
- know about some places of pilgrimage
- understand that the Sacrament of the Sick is an important celebration for those that are ill
- research some of the messages of the Old Testament
- learn the story of the birth of John the Baptist

Parables and saying of Jesus

- know some important Parables and Sayings of Jesus
- understand the Kingdom of God was part of the language Jesus used to explain his preaching about welcoming and accepting God's presence through him
- be able to think of some ways in which the Church lives out this teaching of Jesus

Advent

- prepare to remember the first Coming of Christ and prepare for his second coming during Advent
- know and discuss the messages of those who have proclaimed the coming of Christ
- know the main features of the Christmas story form Matthew's Gospel

Spring

Christmas

- know the main features of the Christmas Story
- understand some of the difficulties faced by the different characters in the story

Baptism

- be able to reference Gospel accounts of the Baptism of Jesus
- be able to describe, sequence, and explain many of the signs, symbols and actions in the Sacrament of Baptism

Lent

- know that Lent is a Season of Change for Christians to become more like Christ
- understand some things that damage human relationships, and the consequences of giving in to temptations that are wrong

 recognise that the Sacrament of Reconciliation is the Church's celebration of God's forgiveness of sin

Holy Week

- know many of the events of the last week of Jesus' life
- understand the reasons why some people wanted to kill Jesus
- know the story of the Passover and recognise links between this story, the Last Supper and the celebration of Mass

Summer

Easter

- know that the Easter Vigil is the Church's Celebration of the Resurrection of Christ
- know the structure of the Vigil, and will understand the meaning attached to some of the symbols used during the Vigil
- be able to discuss the importance of Christian belief in eternal life

Pentecost

- know about the transformation of the Apostles of Jesus through the gift of the Holy Spirit
- know that the Holy Spirit is included in the Church's belief in the Holy Trinity
- be able to discuss some of the qualities of the Holy Spirit

The work of the Apostles

- have a knowledge of the work of the Apostles after Pentecost
- understand some reasons why they were so keen to proclaim the Resurrection of Christ to the world

Marriage and Holy Orders

- know that Marriage and Holy Orders are Sacraments of Commitment
- recall the promises made in Marriage, and key tasks of the Archbishop, Priests and Deacons
- explain the meaning of the Body of Christ as a term for roles and responsibilities of the Church
